The Day the Environmentalist Gave Away His Daughter

My daughter was eight months old when my wife returned to work. I, with occasional help from a neighbour, happily fulfilled my duty as househusband during the day while finding time for anti-nuclear campaigning in the evenings and weekends.

Then one day, I had to attend Carmarthen Magistrates Court to give evidence in a case that had arisen out of the campaign against the building of a nuclear bunker in the town. As I was about to enter the courtroom with baby in arms, the magistrate shouted, 'stop you can't come in here with a baby'. I halted and, on hearing a nearby voice say, 'It's all right, I'll hold the baby for you' I hesitatingly handed our precious little daughter to a man who I didn't know but who I'd seen many times on the bunker campaign. In the courtroom, as the doors closed behind me, I thought, 'oh my God, what have I done'.

As soon as I had given evidence, I rushed towards the exit only to hear the magistrate announce that he was fed up with people continuously coming in and out of the courtroom and instructed the policeman to stop all entries and exits until lunchtime. Horrified, I sat on the edge of the seat gazing at the policeman's boots and wondered how I would inform my wife when she came home from work that I had given away the light of our lives to a stranger.

Then, out of the blue, the magistrate, who had become more and more irate, ran out of patience with proceedings and announced that he was adjourning for an early lunch. In a state of near disbelief, I rushed out to find my baby daughter where I'd left her. She was happily tugging at the beard of a man who looked very relieved to hand her back to her father.
